



PBIS: What is it?

PBIS, also known as **Positive Behavioral Interventions and supports**, is an approach that enhances academic and social behavior outcomes for all students.

The underlying theme is to teach positive behaviors the same way we would teach academic subjects.

At Hilltop, we use **S.O.A.R.** in all areas of our school, as well as our monthly themes and we encourage you to use this at home as well.
