

# TEACHER'S ASSISTANT

There is an opportunity to earn high school graduation credit as a Teacher's Assistant (TA) for senior students. Service credits depend upon the length of service (semester or full year) and upon the quality of that service. Completion of credit as a TA, whether or not it is used to meet graduation requirements, will be recognized on the student's cumulative records and on subsequent transcripts.

## Teacher's Assistant

**Course#:** A-S1 (0607) B-S2 (0608) – 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Elective

**Grade Levels:** 12

**Prerequisites:** None

**Course Description:** The Teacher's Assistant program at the high school will provide opportunities for interested students to seek out learning experiences with high school teachers, media center specialists, administrative assistants or other high school personnel. The teacher/faculty member will determine the responsibilities of the assistant, ranging from clerical tasks to tutoring other students academically. Up to one service unit will be given depending upon the time put in and the type of learning activities successfully completed.

**Basis for Student Success:** Grading will be based on attendance, terms of the Teacher's Assistant contract, and completion of duties as assigned by the teacher. Students will receive a Pass (P) for successful completion of the Teacher's Assistant class or Fail (F) if they violate the attendance policy or otherwise do not meet the standards to pass.
