

HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT BEARING OPTIONS FOR 8TH GRADE

Starting with the class of 2021, WHS credit can be awarded to students taking qualifying Math and World Language courses in 8th grade that are typically only offered to 9-12 graders.

Parents/Students would opt-in by the conclusion of their junior year if wanting to take the credit and letter grade from the applicable course(s) taken in 7th or 8th grades. A [form](#) will be available to families from the school website for submission. The letter grade will be part of a student's cumulative grade point average (GPA) and listed on their official WHS transcript in the 9th grade section.
