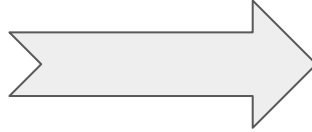

ACT Admission Policies

Most colleges are currently choosing two routes for the ACT

- **Test Optional:** ACT can be a consideration in the admission process if you feel like your score would help your application. If you choose to not submit a score, other factors (GPA, course rigor, activities) will likely be weighted more heavily
- **Test Blind:** Schools will not consider your ACT score as part of your application.

*Most colleges are continuing this policy through 2025



District vs. National ACT

District ACT	National ACT Test
During the school day (ONLINE)	7 Saturday options throughout year
Offered only one time to junior students	Can take numerous times
\$20 cost	\$70 cost
Online registration - will be done through school	Online registration at www.act.org
Paper score report sent to student home, also available through online account created as part of preadministration.	Score report automatically linked to student online account.



DISTRICT ACT TEST at MWHS

- Offered to ALL junior students on Thursday, March 13th
- Online testing option only (will use Chromebook and TestNav)
- Includes writing test
- Yields a college reportable score
- Able to send that score to up to 4 colleges at no charge
- Cost: \$20. Paid through Fee Pay on Skyward Family Access.
 - If you have financial need (qualify for academic benefits) there will be no charge.
- Registration instructions will come through your counselors WIN February 27th.
 - You will NOT register online the same way you do for the national test dates.
 - However, if done correctly, scores from both tests will be linked to the same account.

Advice:

- Save your username and password
- Use your full legal name when registering to ensure all scores are attached to same account
- Take advantage of the opportunity to send score for free now - later \$16
- Check to see if the schools you are interested in require the writing test

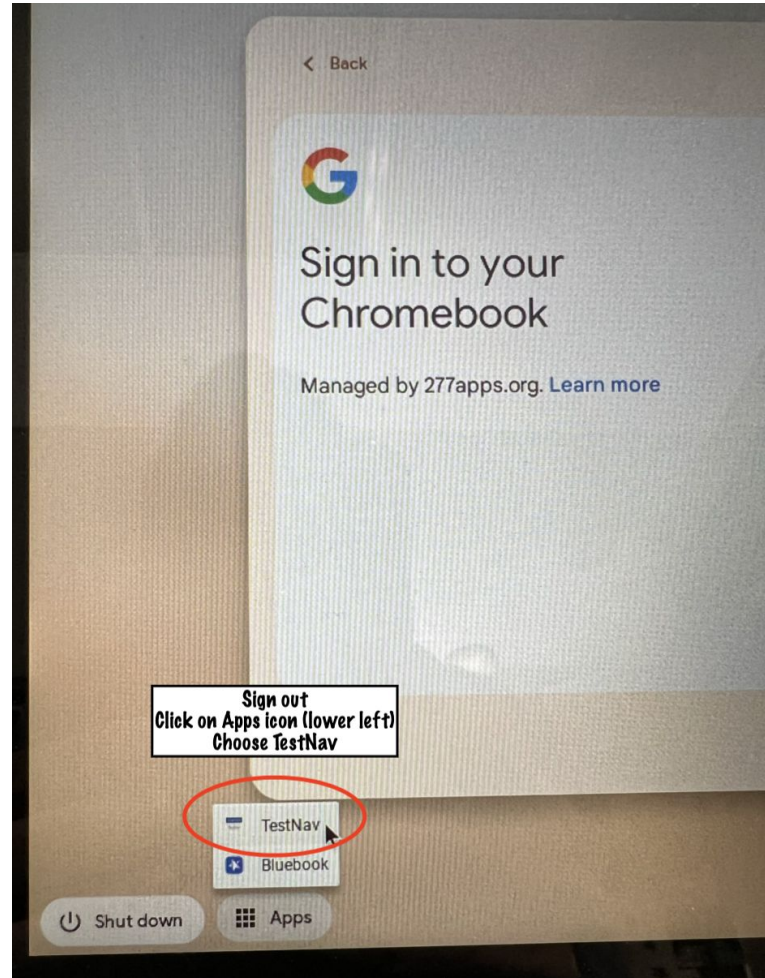

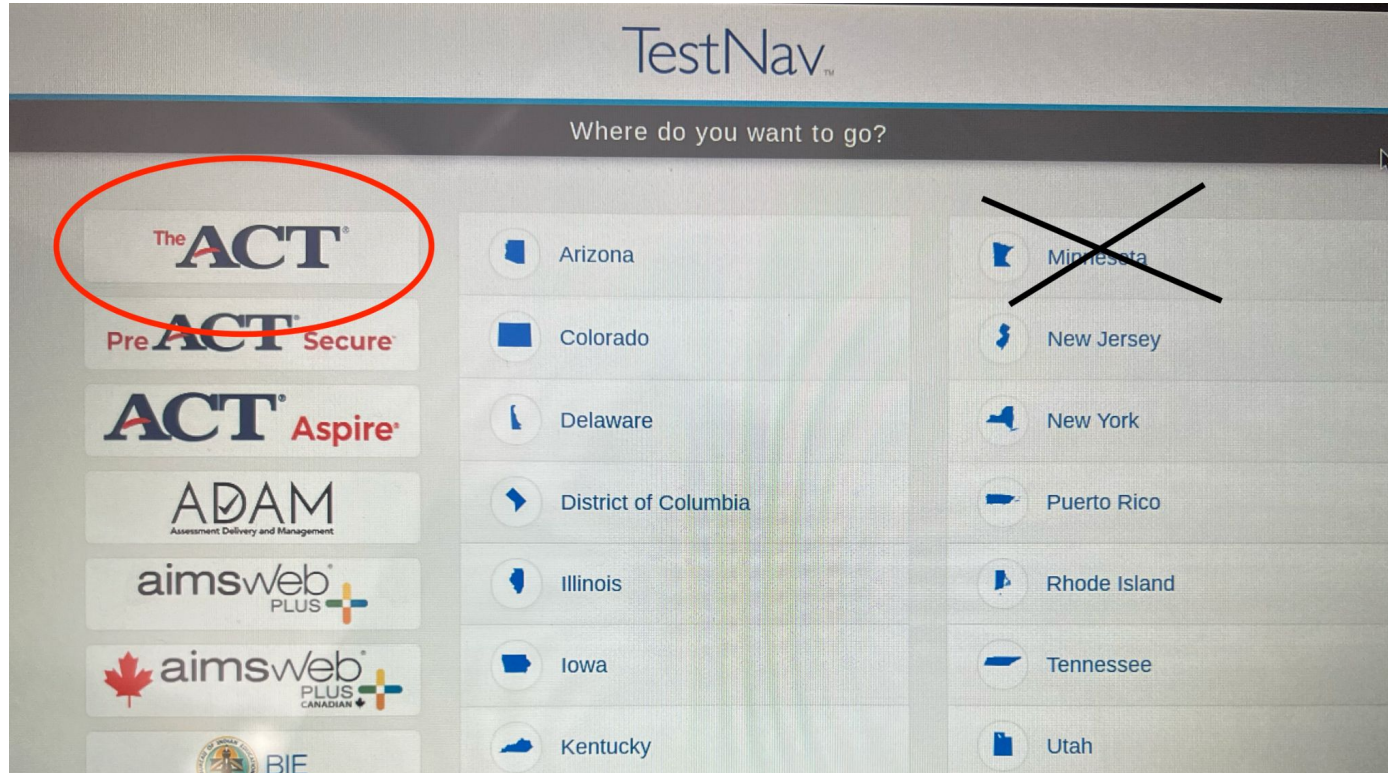
TestNav: Test Prep

3. Choose TestNav



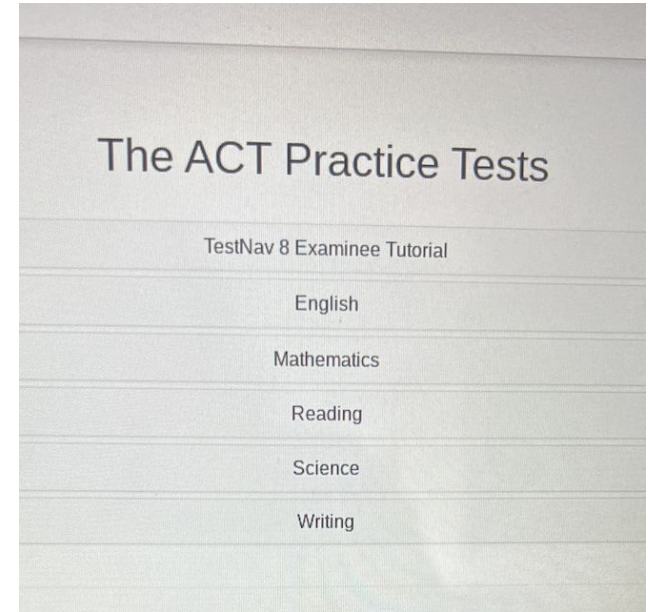

Explore Colleges

1. Click on EDUCATION in the green banner across the top
2. Click on SCHOOLS
3. Expand starting school list to all schools by changing the toggle to NATIONAL
4. Click on the FILTER icon to the right of the search box
5. Identify criteria that are most important when considering a potential college to eliminate those schools that don't meet that criteria: School Type, Location, Admission Difficulty, Programs of Study, School Size, etc.
6. Click on SHOW SCHOOLS and explore matching colleges (drop down for each state)
